Faith

The Greek Word is Pistis – a firm conviction based on hearing of the word of God (Roman 10:17)

Described in the book of **Hebrews 11:1** – "as the substance of things hope for and the evidence of things not seen."

Hebrew 11:6 - Without faith it is impossible to please God.

Ephesians 2:8 - For by grace we are saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God.

2 Cor. 5: 7 – For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Romans 14: 23 - For whatsoever is not of faith is sin.

1. Three kinds of Faith:

- a. **Dead Faith** James 2: 17, 20, 26 Know the Bible, can quote scriptures, but their walk do not measure up to their talk. Faith of intellect in their mind, he or she knows the doctrine of salvation, but they have not submitted themselves to total truth.
- b. Demonic Faith James 2: 18, 19. They believe in God (no atheists), (Mark 3: 11);
 .Demonic Faith is touch with intellect and emotion. (Believe and Tremble)
- c. **Dynamic Faith** Faith based on the word of God (Romans 10:17). Based on intellect, emotion, and will. The mind understands truth, causes one to desire and rejoices in the truth, and the will acts upon the truth
